Tip Of The Month:

When scheduling a patient for an exam, please keep in mind that their **chief complaint** (primary concern) will determine if they are being seen for a medical eye exam or a routine vision exam. We should not be seeing medical complaints for routine vision exams, and we can't "file medical" if they **don't** have any **medical complaints or concerns** (for example: they don't have vision insurance and are *only* coming in because they want a new spec Rx). In other words, we can't use our exam findings to steer the way we file. It's the **chief complaint** that needs to determine which type of insurance is used (medical vs. vision).

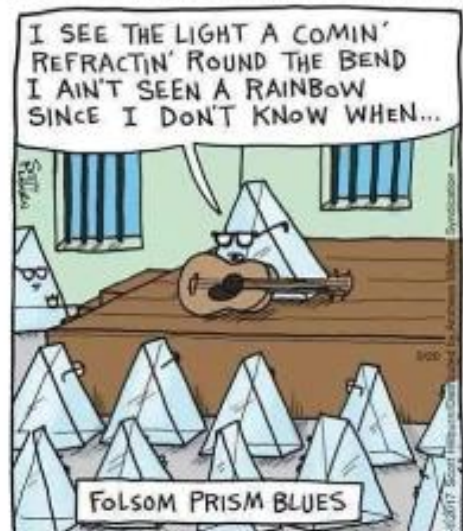
