If you are telling patients about Optos, don't tell them that it *will* replace dilation. While this *is* often the case, there are times when we still need to dilate. Diabetic patients, checking cataracts, new patients, and poor quality photos are just a few examples of when we might need to dilate even with Optos. The Optomap shows *great* detail, but does limit peripheral views at times.
